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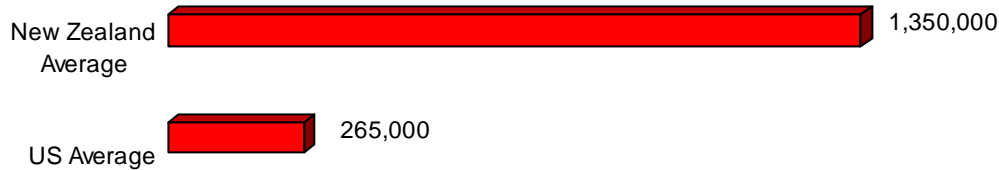
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IS ALL COLOSTRUM REALLY SAFE?

According to the National Mastitis Council (www.nmconline.org), a non-profit organization that helps support the US dairy industry, the term "somatic" means, "derived from the body" and all milk contains white blood cells, known as somatic cells. In the United States, a proposed regulation states that the maximum permissible somatic cell count (SCC/ml) in milk considered suitable for human consumption should be 500,000. A recent study by the National Mastitis Council found that the average SCC/ml is actually about 265,000. SCC/ml above the permissible limits are considered abnormal and indicative of an infection in the udder, possibly rendering the milk unsafe for humans.

AVERAGE SOMATIC CELL COUNTS (SCC/ML)



The average SCC/ml for New Zealand cows (1,350,000/ml) was obtained directly from the web-site of the New Zealand Dairy Board (www.nzdairy.co.nz) for the colostrum production year 1999.
